Governor and Trustee Training



We believe that good quality and relevant training is essential if Governing Boards and Trust Boards are to discharge their responsibilities effectively and efficiently.

This year we have also launched a 10-module e-learning series which introduces governors and trustees to the key principles of effective SEND governance, including statutory responsibilities, funding structures, and the importance of inclusive practice to strengthen strategic leadership and oversight of SEND provision across schools.

In addition to training courses, we hold termly Chairs Briefings – preparing for the term, these are open to all governors and trustees and will include a termly agenda briefing and cover local and national changes and developments you need to be aware of. It will also provide an opportunity to network with other governors/trustees.

All training courses are held virtually via MS Teams or Zoom.
